Watauga County, North Carolina is soliciting bids from qualified firms to furnish, deliver and install furniture as outlined in this solicitation.

Bidders are required to comply with the non-collusion requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents.

The County reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids, including, without limitation, nonconforming, non-responsive, unbalanced, or conditional bids. The County also reserves the right to waive informalities and request clarification as needed.

Watauga County encourages good faith effort outreach to Minority Businesses (HUB Certified) and Small Businesses.

3 BID SUBMISSION

3.1 BID SUBMISSION DEADLINE

Electronic bids are to be received by the Watauga County Administration c/o Melanie Goodson, RID for Watauga County Emergency Services Facility Furniture *until* November 25th. 2025 at 2:30 PM EDT. Late bids will not be accepted.

3.2 BID DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS

All Bids can be submitted via email – no more than 6MB or delivered in person. Hard copy bids must include a USB Flash Drive of Bid Package and be in a sealed box or opaque envelope plainly marked as follows:

Your company name and the solicitation name must be visible on the cover page.

There is no expressed or implied obligation for Watauga County to reimburse firms for any expenses incurred in preparing Bids in response to this request.

Watauga County reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive technicalities and to make such selection deemed in its best interest. With limited response, Watauga County reserves the right to extend the solicitation opening date as appropriate in order to assure a competitive procurement.

3.3 BID QUESTIONS

Bid questions will be due on or before **November 19th, 2025 at 5:00 PM** local time. The primary purpose of this is to provide participating Contractors with the opportunity to ask questions, in writing, related to the IFB.

3.4 BID ADDENDUM

Watauga County may modify the IFB prior to the date fixed for submission of Bids by the issuance of an addendum. It is the bidder's responsibility to periodically check the County's website until the posted Bid Deadline to obtain any issued addenda.

Should an Offeror find discrepancies or omissions in this IFB or any other documents provided by Watauga County, the Offeror should immediately notify the County of such potential discrepancy in writing via email as noted above.

Any addenda to these documents shall be issued in writing. No oral statements, explanations, or commitments by anyone shall be of effect unless incorporated in the written addenda. Receipt of Addenda shall be acknowledged by the Offeror on <u>Appendix</u> C – Addendum and Anti-Collusion Form.

4 INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 COMMUNICATIONS

All communications, any modifications, clarifications, amendments, questions, responses or any other matters related to the Invitation for Bid (IFB) must be made only through the Procurement Contact noted on the cover of this IFB. A violation of this provision is cause for the County to reject a Company's bid. No contact regarding this document with other County employees is permitted and may be grounds for disqualification.

4.2 BIDDERS ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 90 days after the Bid Opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.

4.3 DUPLICATE BIDS

No more than one (1) bid from any Bidder will be considered by the County. In the event multiple bids are submitted in violation of this provision, the County will have the right to determine which bid will be considered, or at its sole option, reject all such multiple bids.

4.4 BID SIGNATURES

An authorized company official must electronically sign Bids. Each signature represents binding commitment upon the Bidder to provide the goods and/or services offered to the County if the Bidder is determined to be the lowest responsive, responsible Bidder.

4.5 BIDDERS RESPONSIBILITIES

The Bidder must be capable, either as a firm or a team, of providing all parts as described herein. Exclusion of any parts or services for this Bid may serve as cause for rejection.

The successful Bidder will be responsible for all work in this solicitation whether they are provided or performed by the successful Bidder or subcontractor(s). Further, the County

will consider the successful Bidder to be the sole point of contact with regard to contractual matters, including payment of any and all charges resulting from the cost of any contract. The successful Bidder must be an authorized dealer of the proposed scale and associated equipment. This manufacturer authorization must include required installation certifications and warranty work provisions.

4.6 PROPOSAL SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

Provide a single **bookmarked PDF** with the following information in the order shown:

- a) Cover letter on the Bidder's letterhead, summarizing the pricing total and outlining the vendors' terms and conditions, signed by the representative managing the account.
- b) Provide supporting documentation to validate items included in your proposal meet or exceed all requirements for the items this IFB. Include manufacturer's cut sheets and/or specifications/price pages with specified features clearly highlighted for each item submitted, demonstrating the product submitted meets or exceeds the Basis of Design in terms of quality/grade and specified features. Do not include entire brochures of proposed items.

4.7 REFERENCES

The bidder must provide a minimum of three client references that include the purchase and installation of furniture of similar type of furniture within the last three years. Watauga County has the right to contact these references to determine customer satisfaction of product, construction, and maintenance of the proposed furniture.

5 INTRODUCTION

5.1 COUNTY

Based in Northwestern North Carolina, Watauga County's emergency services department handles all emergency management phases—preparedness, mitigation, response, and recovery—and maintains disaster response plans.

5.2 PURPOSE

Watauga County, North Carolina, through Clark Nexsen, Inc. a JMT Company, is soliciting bids from qualified firms to furnish, deliver and install furniture as outlined in this solicitation. This project is a new building to house Watauga County's emergency services department. The building will be approximately 25,330 square feet.

6 SCOPE

Watauga County is soliciting bids for the purchase, delivery and installation of all furniture listed on <u>Appendix A –Price Form</u> for the new Watauga County Emergency Services Facility located at Innovation Drive, in the community of Boone, North Carolina. The emergency services facility will support all emergency management phases. The items

contained in this solicitation were selected to achieve design aesthetics, quality, and cost desired for specific needs appropriate for this project. An emphasis was given to **environmental impact** of both manufacturers and specific products and items **manufactured in North Carolina** and surrounding areas. Although manufacturers are listed as a basis for design, it is not the intent to discriminate against an "or equal" product. It is the intent to set a definite standard. Open competition is expected and desired but, in all cases, complete supporting data must be submitted on or before, **November 19th at 5:00 PM** local time, on all substitutions and exceptions proposed. Samples and/or documentation shall be submitted for comparison when requested. Bidders are requested to offer only equivalent comparable units, which will provide the features and performance as indicated in Procurement Specifications.

All Products and component parts furnished under the Contract shall be new, shall comply with the specifications and terms and conditions set forth in this IFB, and shall operate in full compliance with these Specifications.

<u>Note</u>: Because of the differences between manufacturers in the design, materials and construction methods, the County reserves the right to evaluate all bids/proposals and to vary from these specifications when in its opinion, such variances are in the County's best interest. This includes the approval of substitutions by the bidder for one item for another as being equal to specifications, performance and quality. The specifications and requirements described are to indicate certain features requested by the County and are in no way to be construed to be restrictive to eliminate any item or items which are necessary to provide a comprehensive, safe and fully functional furniture system.

Bidder must have a permanent office and installers located within 100 miles of project site for project installation and future service requirements.

Drawings files will be provided after award. Drawings in PDF format are included in <u>Appendix G</u> for Bidder's use. Quantities listed in this IFB are provided as a courtesy to aid in assessing the project for scope of work. The Proposing Bidder must validate quantities. **Final order quantities will be the responsibility of the Bidder awarded the project.**

Clearly define all finish grades in the proposal. Finish samples (finishes and fabrics) are not required at this time.

Freight, design, installation, project management, and any other anticipated fees/costs must be identified for the total project, based on the floor plans provided with this IFB. These items and any other anticipated fees/costs must be separate line items.

7 SPECIFICATIONS

7.1 PROCUREMENT SPECIFICATIONS

Procurement Item Specification Sheets are included in Appendix F.

7.2 SUBSTITUTIONS/EXCEPTIONS

ΑII substitutions exceptions emailed and proposed must be to melanie.goodson@clarknexsen.com no later than 5:00 PM EDT on November 19th, 2025 at 5:00 PM. Submit requests to consist of manufacturer, model description, part number, website address, manufacturer's location, environmental certifications, warranty and detailed specification for the requested substitution/exception. Provide product technical data/specification documents. Please do not include any sales or marketing brochures. The email subject line should read: Exception Request for IFB Watauga County Emergency Services Facility Furniture. After review by County staff, the decision to accept or reject the proposed exception or "Like Model" will be issued by Addendum.

The County reserves the right to review any exceptions and determine acceptability. Failure to note exceptions will result in rejection of bid.

7.3 SUBCONTRACTOR

If subcontractors (including but not limited to contract installers) are to be used on this project, please submit with bid the following information:

- Company Name
- Contact Name and Title
- Address
- Direct Phone Number
- Email Address

A contractor whose Bid is accepted shall not substitute any person as subcontractor in the place of the subcontractor listed in the original bid, except (a) if the listed subcontractor's bid is later determined by the contractor to be non-responsible or nonresponsive or the listed subcontractor refuses to enter into a contract for the complete performance of the bid work, or (b) with the approval of the awarding authority for good cause shown by the contractor.

The terms, conditions, and requirements of each contract between Contractor and a subcontractor performing work under a subdivision or branch of work listed in this subsection shall incorporate by reference the terms, conditions, and requirements of the Contract between Contractor and Owner. Failure to include this list of subcontractors may cause a Bid to be rejected as nonresponsive by Owner.

If Owner, after due investigation, has reasonable objection to any proposed Subcontractor, Supplier, individual, or entity, Owner may, before the Notice of Award is given, request apparent Successful Bidder to submit a substitute, without an increase in the Bid.

Subsequent to the submittal of the Bid, Owner may not require the Successful Bidder or Contractor to retain any Subcontractor, Supplier, or other individual or entity against which Contractor has reasonable objection.

7.4 DEVIATIONS

Any deviation from these specifications must be submitted as a written substitution request before the stated deadline. If no request is submitted, the offer will be deemed fully compliant and the awarded bidder will be responsible for meeting all specifications.

7.5 WARRANTY

Watauga County requires, at a minimum, a 1-year unlimited warranty, unless otherwise indicated on Procurement Specification Sheets, on all furniture including installation. Provide warranty information on Appendix A – Price Form.

7.6 QUOTATION AND ORDERING RESPONSIBILITY

The vendor shall independently review, verify, and validate all quotations without reliance on Clark Nexsen or Watauga County review. Clark Nexsen and Watauga County expressly disclaim any obligation to review vendor quotations or orders. The vendor assumes full responsibility for quotation accuracy, order quantities, specifications, and all associated procurement decisions. Any errors or omissions in quotations or ordering shall be the vendor's sole liability.

7.7 SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Vendor shall:

- Prior to order placement, visit the site, compare the drawings and specifications, and be informed of all conditions, including other work being performed and prevailing labor transportation conditions. There shall be no additional cost to the County due to unanticipated difficulties or costs of performance by the Bidder.
- 2. Be responsible for receiving, warehousing, delivering and completing the installation of all items.
- 3. Be responsible for installation and furnish their own installation crew, who are uniformed and have been certified and/or trained to install, assemble, disassemble, reconfigure, relocate or repair office furniture, and arrange for the crew to be at the job site at the dates and times prearranged with the County.
- 4. Provide adequate, competent supervision for installation, by a supervisor experienced in the type of work involved.
- 5. Have the sole responsibility for payment of any overtime expenses, unless and to the extent that overtime is requested in writing by the County and the County agrees to pay this expense.
- 6. Protect existing amenities of the site during the project and shall be held liable for any resulting damage(s).
- 7. Provide and maintain protective coverings for floors, walls, and door frames at all building entries, corridors, and work areas throughout delivery and installation. Remove protection only after final inspection and approval.
- 8. Have a complete set of furniture plans at the job site during the entire installation process. The installation will not be allowed to proceed without final furniture plans.
- 9. Be responsible for installation of all new materials.
- 10. Be responsible for a full and complete furniture power installation and coordinate with

owner's electrician.

- 11. Provide final power connections to the building junction boxes.
- 12. Coordinate with County IT personnel for running data cabling by others.
- 13. Coordinate installations of furnishings with current MEP / Low Voltage locations prior to installation.
- 14. Remove all packaging and crating debris from the building as the installation progresses. No dumpster will be available for use at the job site.
- 15. Be responsible for all cleanup of area following completion of project.
- 16. Inspect furnishings for damage and/or defects.
- 17. Assume responsibility for any damages, errors, or omissions attributable to the shipper, manufacturer, or installation and reorder products for like in new condition.
- 18. Coordinate all warranty services and provide copies of warranties & maintenance information.
- 19. Comply with security and safety requirements while on the job site.
- 20. Provide anticipated delivery dates for all items within 3 weeks of bid award.
- 21. Must notify the County if the anticipated delivery date changes.
- 22. Attend requested meetings as required for building access and general site coordination.

7.8 DELIVERY AND CHARGES

No additional freight shall be charged at time of delivery. Risk of loss and/or damage shall be upon the seller until such time as goods have been physically delivered and received by the County.

7.9 TAXES:

Watauga County Emergency Services Facility is NOT tax-exempt. Unless otherwise indicated, tax must be computed and added to your bid. Any itemized shipping charges are also subject to tax.

8 EVALUATION OF BIDS AND AWARD PROCEDURES

8.1 BID INFORMATION

Bids must be made in strict conformance using the Invitation for Bid (IFB) forms provided herein. All blank spaces for bids must be filled in properly.

All Bid Documents shall signed by an individual who is authorized to contractually bind the company. The signature must indicate the title or position the individual holds in the agency or firm. Agencies or firms which sign contracts with the name of the agency or firm

must provide the name of a corporate officer or executive director for signature validation by the County. **All unsigned Bids will be disqualified.** In submitting a Bid, Offeror affirms all statements contained in the bid are true and accurate.

8.2 TERMS OF SUBMISSION

All material received from a person or company ("Respondent") in response to this solicitation shall become the property of Watauga County and will not be returned to the Respondent. Any and all costs incurred by a Respondent in preparing, submitting, or presenting submissions are the Respondent's sole responsibility and Watauga County shall not reimburse the Respondent. All responses to this solicitation will be considered a public record and subject to disclosure under applicable public records law.

8.3 BID AWARD

Award will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder who meets the requirements listed in this bid document.

The County reserves the right to reject any and all bids, the right to waive informalities, and the right to disregard nonconforming or conditional bids or counter proposals. If the contract is to be awarded, it will be awarded to the lowest responsible, responsible bidder whose evaluation by the County indicates that the award will be in the best interest of County. The County shall have a period of 60 days after opening of bids in which to award the contract.

8.4 APPLICATION OF NORTH CAROLINA GENERAL STATUTES

The General Statutes of North Carolina regarding purchasing and competitive bidding (G.S. § 143-129) are made a part herein and will govern the bidding process as applicable.

9 GENERAL CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

9.1 MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDERS

Bids shall be considered only from companies normally engaged in performing the type of work specified in this solicitation. Watauga County, in its discretion, shall determine whether the evidence of responsibility and ability to perform is satisfactory.

The individual/firm warrants that he/she is fully qualified, with adequate personnel and experience, to undertake the services required. The Offeror shall also certify that insurance coverage that meets or exceeds industry standards for this type of work will be in force to mitigate risk during performance under the contract.

9.2 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All payroll taxes, liability and worker's compensation are the sole responsibility of the Offeror. The Offeror understands that an employer/employee relationship does not exist under this contract.

All bids submitted in response to this request shall become the property of Watauga County and as such may be subject to public review.

9.3 CERTIFICATION

In response to the IFB Request, the Contractor certifies the following:

- This bid is signed by an authorized representative of the firm.
- It can obtain insurance certificates as required within ten (10) calendar days after notice of award.
- All labor costs, direct and indirect, have been determined and included in the proposed cost.
- The potential Contractor has read and understands the conditions set forth in this solicitation.

9.4 FINANCIAL INFORMATION

The Bidder must have the following financial information readily available and have the ability to provide it to the County, without exception, within twenty-four (24) hours upon request during the bid certification process:

- 1. Annual audited financial reports for the past five (5) fiscal years.
- 2. Credit reports, credit bulletins, bank and vendor references, and any other published statements by agencies that have been issued or published about the entity within the past five (5) years.
- 3. Indicate whether the Company (and/or predecessor, guarantor, or subcontractor) has declared bankruptcy within the last five (5) years.
- 4. Provide a description of the financial impact of any past or pending legal proceedings and judgments that could materially affect the Bidder's financial position or ability to provide service to the County.

9.5 CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATIONS

The contents of this Bid and the commitments set forth in the Bid shall be considered contractual obligations if a contract ensues. Failure to accept these obligations may result in cancellation of the award. All legally required terms and conditions shall be incorporated into final contract agreements with the awarded bidder.

9.6 COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

Seller represents and warrants that the performance of this order and the furnishing of goods or services required shall be in accordance with the applicable standards, provisions and stipulations of all pertinent Federal, State or County laws, rules, regulations, resolutions and ordinances including but not limited to the Fair Labor Standards Act, the Equal Employment Opportunity rules and regulations and the Occupational Safety and Health Acts.

9.7 MODIFICATION OR WITHDRAWAL OF BID

Prior to the scheduled closing time for receiving bids, any Contractor may withdraw his bid. After the scheduled closing time for receiving bids, no bid may be withdrawn for 90 days. Only written requests for the modification or correction of a previously submitted bid that are addressed in the same manner as bids and are received by the County prior to the closing time for receiving bids will be accepted. The bid will be corrected in accordance with such written requests, provided that any such written request is in a sealed envelope that is plainly marked "Modification of Bid." Oral, telephone or fax modifications or corrections will not be recognized or considered.

9.8 DISPUTES

In case of any doubt or differences of opinion as to the services to be furnished hereunder, the decision of the County shall be final and binding upon both parties.

9.9 CONTRACT COMMENCEMENT

Commencement of a contract shall not begin prior to all necessary County approvals, including County School Board approval where required, and receipt of a County Purchase Order. Commencement of a contract without these approvals is solely at the Bidder's own risk and is likely to result in no payment for services performed or goods received.

9.10 RIGHT OF CANCELLATION

Any contract agreement entered into with the County that requires ongoing payments after the end of the fiscal year in which the equipment is purchased is cancelable by the County in the event that continuing funds are not appropriated.

9.11 EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

All Companies will be required to follow Federal Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) policies. Watauga County will affirmatively assure that on any project constructed pursuant to this advertisement, equal employment opportunity will be offered to all persons without regard to race, color, creed, religion, national origin, sex, and marital status, status with regard to public assistance, membership or activity in a local commission, disability, sexual orientation, or age.

9.12 MINORITY AND SMALL BUSINESS PARTICIPATION PLAN

It is the policy of Watauga County that Minority Businesses (MBEs), Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs) and other small businesses shall have the opportunity to compete fairly in contracts financed in whole or in part with public funds. Consistent with this policy, Watauga County will not allow any person or business to be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise be discriminated against in connection with the award and performance of any contract because of sex, race, religion, or national origin.

9.13 LICENSES

The successful Firm(s) shall have and maintain a valid and appropriate business license (if applicable), meet all local, state, and federal codes, and have current all required local, state, and federal licenses.

9.14 COMPLIANCE WITH E-VERIFY

Provider shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations in providing services under this Contract. In particular, Provider shall not employ any individuals to provide services to the School System who are not authorized by federal law to work in the United States. Provider represents and warrants that it is aware of and in compliance with the Immigration Reform and Control Act and North Carolina law (Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes) requiring use of the E-Verify system for employers who employ twenty-five (25) or more employees and that it is and will remain in compliance with these laws at all times while providing services pursuant to this Contract.
