District Report – Graham Fox

95-2020-001 Matt Duval – Graham Fox is going out to measure fence and check on the last drinker. If it is okay, he will do the RFP for this contract.

95-2019-006 Justin Eggers- client wanted a feed barn. After researching we can only do feed pads. Graham contacted Mr. Eggers and let him know what we can do. Justin told Graham he was still interested and would finance the rest himself. The Engineers are still working on the design.

95-2020-002 Jeff Brown- would like to do an addition to the access road we done on the last contract. Jeff Brown came by the office and stated they were interested in building a house up on top of the hill and could they use the access road to get to it. Graham Fox explained they can't fund roads for driveways. They are responsible for maintaining that access road for 10 years. If they build and use that road to get to the house with in the next 10 years, they will be out of compliance. Then they will have to bring it back into compliance. Most likely paying the money back for the road.

A client wanted to bring Veterans Preference before the Board. After discussion the Board voted.

Chris Hughes made a motion to use the same rules that USDA (NRCS, FSA) use. Veteran Farmer or Rancher- The term "Veteran Farmer or Rancher" means a producer who served in the United States Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, or Coast Guard, including the reserve components thereof; was released from the service under conditions other that dishonorable; and-

- Has not operated a farm or ranch, or has operated a farm or ranch for not more than 10 years;
 or
- Who first obtained status as a veteran during the most recent 10-year period?

A legal entity or joint operation can be a Veteran Farmer or Rancher only if all individual members independently qualify.

Bill Moretz seconded; all were in favor.
